

The Red Ribbon club is an educational initiative started by the Government of India in academic institutions to raise awareness about HIV and AIDS among students. Since its establishment in Shri Krishna Mahavidyalaya, Govindgarh, the club has been actively conducting activities such as power point presentations, poster-making competitions, and slogan-writing programmes to educate and engage students in spreading awareness about HIV and AIDS.

The Red Ribbon symbolizes:


- Unity in the fight against HIV/AIDS, representing solidarity among affected individuals.
- A symbol of love, showing empathy and compassion towards those with HIV.
- Represents blood, signifying the suffering issue that needs attention.
- Serves as a reminder that HIV/AIDS remains related deaths.
- As of now, a cure for HIV has not been discovered. The Red Ribbon club serves as a warning sign about the pressing issue of the present time, which is still largely unaddressed.
- The Red Ribbon serves as a symbol of the pain endured by individuals living with HIV/AIDS.
- The Global Symbol of the Red Ribbon was established in the year 1991 in New York.

Red Ribbon club Required:-

The need for Red Ribbon clubs is evident due to the rapid spread of HIV/AIDS among youth. In response, the National AIDS control organization (NACO) is collaboration with the ministry of Health and Family welfare of the Government of India introduced a program to educate young people about HIV/AIDS, specifically HIV/AIDS. This program aimed to prepare a series of initiatives within universities and educational institutions to raise awareness among the youth about HIV/AIDS prevention and promote voluntary blood donation.

Objects :-

- (i) To create awareness and foster empathy among youth in support of people living with HIV/AIDS (PLHWA), it is essential to reduce discrimination and bias.
- (ii) Developing leadership, communication, and team-building skills in young people to inspire and build their capacity as active educators, collaborators, and change agents.
- (iii) Encouraging voluntary blood donation among youth to promote a safe and healthy lifestyle.
- (iv) Increasing awareness about sexual and reproductive health and HIV/AIDS.
- (v) Enhancing the capacity for effective communication and influencing skills among youth, both for self-protection and in peer groups.
- (vi) Fostering an environment conducive to healthy and secure living for educators, allowing them to lead by example among young people.
- (vii) To create an environment capable of living a healthy and safe life by enhancing the capacity of peer teachers.

The program is being implemented through non-governmental organizations in collaboration with universities to effectively manage the Red Ribbon Clubs (RRCs). The programme is coordinated by officials and collaborating educators. Non-governmental organization will train the nodal teachers and collaborating educators with the initial assistance of trained resource persons.

Nodal teachers and collaborating educators will conduct interactive sessions with students from targeted colleges, focusing on five main areas:

1. Promoting healthy living skills and creating a stress-free environment.
2. Substance abuse prevention.
3. Promotion of blood donation.
4. Developing life skills and fostering good dietary habits.
5. Raising awareness about RTI / STI, sexual health, HIV/AIDS, and reproductive health.





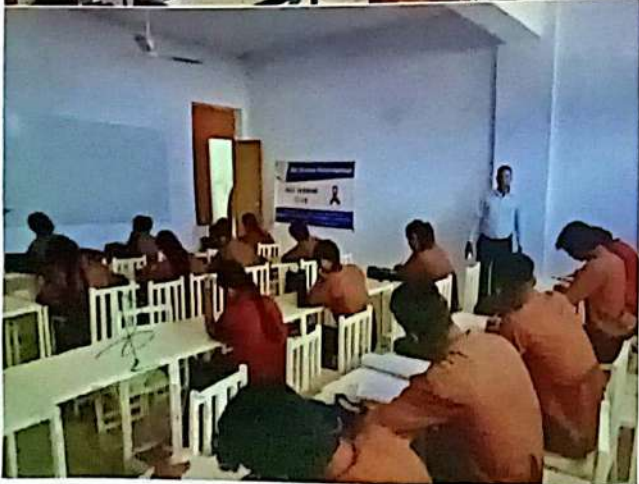


3. Drug prevention program




Organization of AIDS Quiz competition


Program No. 5 : AIDS Day Celebration



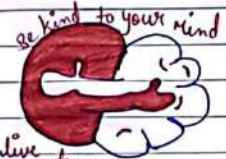
